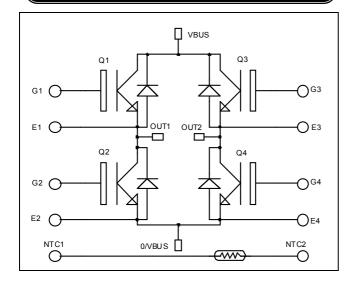

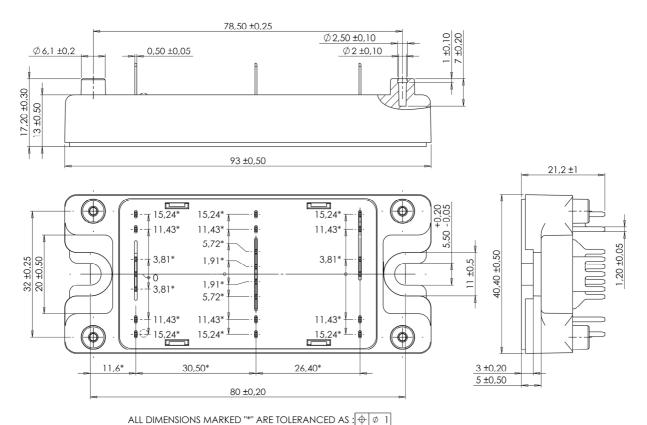

### SP4 Package outline (dimensions in mm)

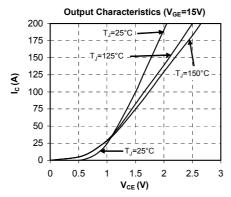


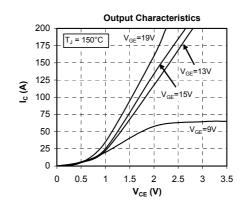

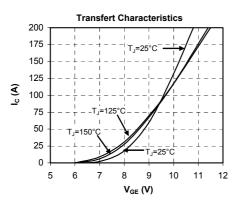
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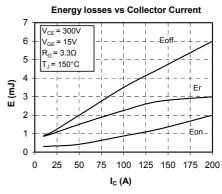


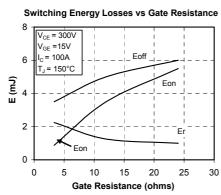
### **Typical Performance Curve**

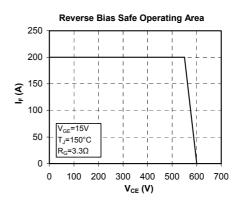


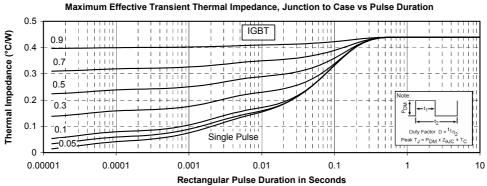




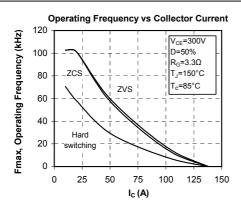


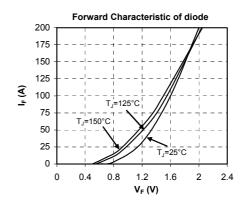


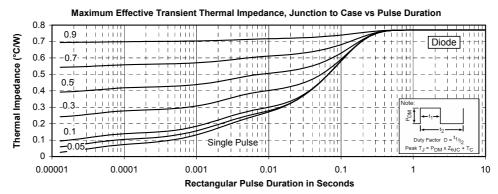














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
